On Monday this week the Trump Administration announced it would <u>stop funding UNFPA</u> (the UN Population Fund) because the organisation allegedly "supports, or participates in the management of, a program of coercive abortion or involuntary sterilization" in China. Guess what? They <u>actually don't</u> — and activists say that because they are one of few organisations <u>promoting a rights-based approach to family planning in China</u>, their defunding could actually result in more coercion.

Finally, if you're not based at a university and are struggling to find journal articles because of paywalls, the LSE Impact blog has some good news and an (entirely legal) <u>helpful tool</u>.
