

Phase 1 of the 2015 aid stakeholder survey now live

We've just pressed send on the first phase of the [2015 aid stakeholder survey](#). Surveys have now been sent to over 150 senior executives from Australia's development NGOs and contractors, and close to 100 in New Zealand. The surveys, tailored to the Australian and New Zealand aid programs and linked to each individual participant, will obtain feedback on the effectiveness of the respective programs and provide suggestions for their improvement. The second phase of the survey, which will be publicly available online for all to fill out, will be launched in early August.
